By partnering together, you would help us put Belgium on the World's stage map, and you would also help your brand that little bit more.

In this document, we'd like to present to you our project, and hopefully build a partnership that would be profitable to both of us.

Let's conquer the World Ultimate Championships together.

Project description

The World Ultimate Championship will be held from 31 August to 7 September 2024 in Gold Coast, Australia.

The event should gather around 2000+ players from all over the world and from all genders, as the tournament will be composed of Open, Women and Mixed divisions.

Belgium is planning on sending at least one team, in the Open division. Being the European champion in that category, it would be a non-sense not to send a team to "Worlds".

A mixed and a women's teams are still being discussed.

The open team will be composed of 26 players, and up to 4 staff members. All players are amateur, bearing all the costs by themselves. Despite some help provided by various institutions such as Adeps and Sport Vlaanderen, we estimate the costs to go up to 3,500€ per player.

It is important to stress the fact that all players put the same type of commitment as semi-professional athletes in other sports such as football (soccer) or hockey, without earning anything.

In Ultimate, there isn't any sort of prize of money at the end of a tournament. Only the honor of winning.



What is Ultimate Frisbee?

Born in the United States in 1968, Ultimate Frisbee is a self-refereed team sport played with a Frisbee. A match is played 7 against 7 on a field 100 meters long and 36 meters wide.

There are now several million Ultimate players around the world. Ultimate is the fastest-growing sport in the world in terms of participants. This encouraged the International Olympic Committee (IOC) to officially recognise Ultimate Frisbee in 2015.

In addition to its ever-growing popularity, it is above all the sport's two key values that have attracted the IOC's attention: **fair play and diversity.**

On the field, players are responsible for any fouls they commit, and each player has the power to stop the game, so from a very young age, the notion of fair play is emphasized in order to make each player aware of his or her responsibilities. In Ultimate, it's essential to know the rules, and to play with respect for others.

In terms of diversity, tournaments usually comprise three main divisions: Open (mostly male-matching players), Mixed (50-50) and Women, in different age categories.

Apart from these aspects, the sport is very demanding in terms of physical fitness, pure technique and strategy/vision of the game, which makes it an attractive challenge for many people.

The Belgium National team



At club level, Mooncatchers (Brussels) finished at the 4th place of the Worlds Ultimate Club championships in July 2022 in Cincinnati, USA, in the Open division.

Most recently, the U24 Open national team took silver at the World's U24 championship in Nottingham, UK.

In December 2022, Belgium won the European Indoor Championship title in the Open division, claiming the first gold medal of the country's history in a major tournament.

Finally, last July, Belgium won the European Outdoor Championship title in the Open division in Limerick, Ireland. Winning "Euros" is the highest achievement a country can get in Europe.

However, there is still one more competition Belgium needs to prove itself: Worlds Ultimate Championship.

Estimated costs

All these costs are estimated based on a travel of 10 days (7 days of tournaments + 3 days of acclimatation before the tournament).
